Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

Alyssa Pearson submitted an application to install a sign on her business at 146 N. Sharpe Ave. Hayden Pearson appeared before the commission on behalf of Magnolia Proper and Sweet Annie's Cupboard. The new metal sign will be attached to the existing shingle style awning. The sign will be 3' x 6'. Judy Dilworth made a motion to approve the application and Jordan Goins seconded the motion. The vote was all in favor of the motion.


