

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE

**Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes**

After review of the minutes of the March 2022 meeting, Mickey Thompson made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, Lisa Miller seconded the motion. The vote was "aye" with no opposition.

**New Business**

Alan Morgan, on behalf of the Grover Homeowners' Association, submitted an application to replace the windows on the building located at 109 S. Sharpe Avenue. Some of the windows in the building were damaged by recent storms, and some of the windows were leaking prior to the storms. Some of the windows will be replaced now, and the others will all be replaced at a later date. The new windows will have to be special ordered to fit the existing opening, and delivery time may be 8 to 10 weeks. Lisa Miller made a motion to approve the application, with the condition that all existing windows be replaced with the same new windows. The commission requested that the Grover Homeowners' Association provide a letter to the Heritage Commission stating that this will be stipulated. Judy Dilworth seconded the motion. The vote in favor of the motion was unanimous.
