The Bank Plus branch will receive a substantial interior renovation. The exterior of the building will receive a couple of minor changes including the relocation of the ATM, which is currently located on the front of the building, and a replacement of the main public entry door and frame. The ATM will move from its current location to the rear of the building near the drive through. Mickey Thompson made a motion to approve the application for the exterior work, and Judy Dilworth seconded the motion. The vote was all in favor of the motion.



If the doors have to be replaced, Ms. Edmonds will need to reappear before the commission. Jordan Goins made a motion to approve the application for the sign and the paint color. Cetin Oguz seconded the motion. The vote was all in favor.

Cetin Oguz gave a brief report on the Preservation Bootcamp which he attended in May.
