New Business

Taylor Summers has submitted an application to install a sign on the front of the building located at 106 A South Sharpe Avenue. Mr. Summers spoke by phone to the commission regarding the sign, which will be 4' x 12' and will attach to the existing metal siding on the front of the building. The background color will be peppercorn with white letters. After questions and discussion, Judy Dilworth made a motion to accept Mr. Summers' request. Cetin Oguz seconded the motion. The vote was "aye" with no opposition.

Danny Griffin has submitted an application on behalf of USDA to install a sign on the building he owns at 123 South Court Street. The new sign will be 30" x 28". Lajan Van Vulpen of Jacks, Griffin, and Luciano spoke to the commission and presented a picture of the new sign. Signs will also be placed on the side of the building for parking spaces. These will be standard USDA signs. After discussion, Corinne Casanova made a motion to accept the request, and Judy Dilworth seconded the motion. The vote was "aye" with no opposition.
