Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

New Business

Dave Alford submitted an application to make repairs to 301 N. Sharpe Avenue, Loft #5. The exterior siding on the south and west of the building is rotten, and needs to be replaced. Mr. Alford will replace the existing siding with a new and appropriate exterior siding. The new siding will be painted to match the existing. Mr. Alford submitted pictures of the siding which needs to be replaced. Jordan Goins made a motion to approve the application, and Judy Wilson seconded the motion. The vote was all in favor of the motion.
