Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

Budget Review

The commission reviewed the November 2025 and December 2025 budget and expenses.

Old Business

1. Betsy Abraham reported that two more signs will be put up in the parking lot for the Breezeway. She spoke with Robinson Electric and let them know that the breezeway lights need to be on every night. Myrtis Tabb said she is working on the quotes for the breezeway flooring.
2. Betsy Abraham is working with Lisa Miller on the bike trail's kiosk sign. Once Lisa completes this, the signs will be printed. Betsy will talk to Cleveland Trophy about printing the signs.
3. The group discussed the need for clean-up around the Cleveland entrance signs on the north and south ends of town.
4. The planters have been placed around the downtown deck.

New Business

1. Earth Day is on April 22, 20226. The date for the Earth Day event has not been set yet. Once the date is set, the flyers will be printed so they can go out as early as possible.
2. Arbor Day is February 13, 2026. Mary Anna has trees, and one tree will be planted.
3. The group discussed setting up a fund through the Cleveland Development Foundation for families who want to have trees planted in memory of their loved ones. Myrtis Tabb mentioned doing some type of temporary signage by the trees for the families. Betsy Abraham will talk to Cleveland Trophy about the signage options.
4. The hanging baskets will be taken to Sarah at CS&S Landscaping soon so they can start working on them for the spring season.
